### Description:

Work alongside industry professionals as the Heart of America Shakespeare Festival presents its 32<sup>nd</sup> season June 11 – June 30, 2024. **Internship dates run May – July, 2024.** Specific dates and times are determined by department supervisor.

Lighting interns' responsibilities may include: setup and strike all production lighting equipment and site infrastructure at the Festival's home in Southmoreland Park, operate a spotlight during performances, and assist with other production duties as needed.

This hands-on internship provides real-world experience working with Kansas City professionals to bring Shakespeare's story to life through a free, outdoor professional production one stitch at a time. College credit can be received through your school/department depending on the applicant's school policies.

### Responsibilities may include:

- Setup and strike all production lighting equipment and site infrastructure at the Festival's home in Southmoreland Park
- Operate a spotlight during performances
- Assist with other production duties as needed
