Description:

Work alongside industry professionals as the Heart of America Shakespeare Festival presents its 33rd season June 17 – July 6, 2025. **Internship dates run May – July, 2025.** Specific dates and times are determined by department supervisor.

Costuming interns' responsibilities may include: sewing and finish work, wig styling and maintenance, laundry, dry-cleaning and maintenance as directed by Wardrobe Master, assisting actors with wigs and costume issues/changes, pre and post-show and backstage costume crew during production run.

This hands-on internship provides real-world experience working with Kansas City professionals to bring Shakespeare's story to life through a free, outdoor professional production one stitch at a time. College credit can be received through your school/department depending on the applicant's school policies.

Responsibilities may include:

- Sewing and finish work
- Wig styling and maintenance
- Laundry, dry-cleaning and maintenance as directed by Wardrobe Supervisor
- Assisting actors with wigs and costume issues/changes
- Pre and post-show and backstage costume crew during production run
