This paid, hands-on internship provides real-world experience working with Kansas City professionals to bring Shakespeare's story to life through a free, outdoor professional production for the city's residents and visitors alike. College credit can be received through your school/department depending on the applicant's school policies.

Responsibilities may include:

- Setup and strike all production lighting equipment and site infrastructure at the Festival's home in Southmoreland Park
- Operate a spotlight during performances
- Assist with other production duties as needed
